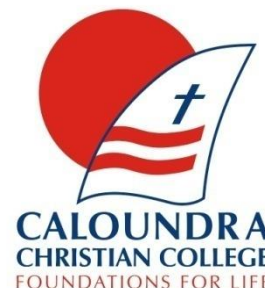

**RE: 2017 INTERHOUSE SWIMMING CARNIVAL FOR YEARS 4 – 12
2017 JUNIOR PRIMARY SWIMMING CARNIVAL FOR PREP – YEAR 3**

On Friday, 27 January 2017, the College Interhouse Swimming Carnival will be held at the Kawana Aquatic Centre commencing at 9:00am.

The aims of the carnival are to select teams to compete at the Independent Primary and Secondary District Carnivals, to celebrate our champion house and swimmers of the day, to have fun and maximise participation. Students are encouraged to be involved during the day, as each completed swim earns one point toward the house tally regardless of results.

TRANSPORT

All regular morning College bus runs will go directly to Kawana Aquatic Centre first to drop off students between Years 4-12. **Students in Years 7 - 12 who do not use the College bus service can be dropped directly to the venue where staff will be on duty from 7:30am.** Upon arrival, students will have their name marked off the roll before going to their house area.

Students in Years 4-6 and those Secondary students who will not be dropped directly to the venue, will be transported from the College by bus from 8:20am. Students must be at the College no later than 8:20am to utilise this service. **Late students must be taken directly to Kawana Aquatic Centre by parents, as staff will not be available to provide a late transport service.**

STUDENT DRESS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Students are to wear the College sports uniform and appropriate footwear on the day. House polo shirts may be worn in lieu of the sports shirt (these can be purchased from the Uniform Shop). Please note: **This IS NOT a free dress day.** Students are encouraged to bring their own packed lunch, however the CCCafé will operate a BBQ (**CASH ONLY**) for lunch.

Students are required to bring/wear:

- Hat and sunscreen
- Water bottle and packed lunch
- Money for BBQ (optional)
- Girls to wear one piece swimmers (if wearing a two-piece students **must** wear a rash shirt over the top)

PREP – YEAR 3 JUNIOR CARNIVAL

The Prep – Year 3 Junior Carnival will be held at the same venue and on the same day as the Year 4 – 12 Carnival. The younger students will attend for a morning of aquatic activities, from 11:00am – 1:00pm returning to the College after lunch. They should bring a hat, sunscreen, water bottle and packed lunch.

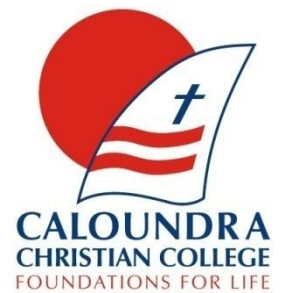
PARENTAL ATTENDANCE AND INVOLVEMENT
